

# Cincinnati United Information

- \* Call field hotlines before every game and practice. If our home field is closed for a game, you're responsible for calling the opposing coach.
- \* Bring player cards and medical release forms to every game. In the event that player cards are forgotten, each player and coach signs his/her name and birthdate on a piece of paper. The paper then goes to the opposing coach and can be turned in to the league to check against the team roster.
- \* Ref \$ -- U8-U9 is \$13 (there is just one ref, so 1 - \$10 and 3 - \$1's)  
    U10 is \$30 each game (I suggest bringing 1 - \$10's, 3 - \$5's, and 5 - \$1's)  
    U11-U12 is \$32 each game (I suggest bringing 1 - \$10's, 3 - \$5's and 7 - \$1's)  
    U13-U14 is \$37 (I suggest bringing 1 - \$10's, 4 - \$5's and 7 - \$1's)  
    U15-U16 is \$44 (I suggest bringing 2 - \$20, and 4 - \$1's)  
I cash it in the denominations that I will need and put each game in a separate envelope.
- \* It is good practice to email or call each coach a week or so ahead of each game to confirm the game time and location. There is almost always one game a season that is changed for some reason and the coach fails to let you know.
- \* Game length: U8-U10 play 25 min. halves  
    U11-U12 play 30 min. halves  
    U13-U14 play 35 min halves  
    U15-U18 play 40 min halves
- \* You can use a penny for a goalie shirt if you want. You should have 2 different color pennies in case the other teams is the same color as your penny.
- \* After each game, you must enter the game score on the CUSL website that same evening. Go to the team administration (same place that player information was added). enter your password, then click on "record a game score." It should be self explanatory from here. Both teams are required to do this.
- \* If a game is rained out, you need to enter that as well, in the same place that you record the game score
- \* If you are preplaying a game or rescheduling a rainout game, you need to enter that on the website. Tourney games must be preplayed (except for the first two weeks of the season, there is typically an explanation of specific dates on the CUSL website each season). Rainouts must be played within 3 weeks of the rainout date.
- \* Should bring a first aid kit with you to each game. Can ask a parent in to be in charge of drinks and/or to bring extra ice for injuries.
- \* Make sure that the players bring both the home and away uniform with them to each game. The home team changes in the event of a color conflict. I suggest that the players keep their extra jersey and extra socks in a ziploc bag in their soccer bag. That way, it stays clean and dry. We also do this with under armour and hats and gloves for the colder games.
- \* Frank Patterson is our field scheduler for CU Sycamore. You need to give him 2 – 3 dates whenever you are rescheduling a game. He will take care of the refs for reschedules as well. He will also take care of contacting the ref coordinator.  
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
